POLICY FOR IN AND OUT SHIPPERS ACCESSING THE HOLLYWOOD CASINO AT PENN NATIONAL RACE COURSE BACKSTRETCH

All commercial and private horse vans entering the stable area must be signed in at the time of entry by a Pennsylvania Horse Racing licensed individual who accepts responsibility for the safe delivery and stabling of the horses on the van. Out of state ship ins must have an in-slip signed by the Stall Superintendant on file with the stable gate, to allow access prior to the trainer's arrival.

Horses leaving the stable area by horse van must be shipped by a commercial shipper, a valid Pennsylvania Horse Racing licensee, or a previously signed in individual. A valid Pennsylvania Horse Racing license or a day pass must be shown and recorded at the stable gate any time a horse leaves the backstretch by vehicle or pedestrian.

Any individual not properly licensed or approved will be denied access to the backstretch.
